If yes, what grade were you in?

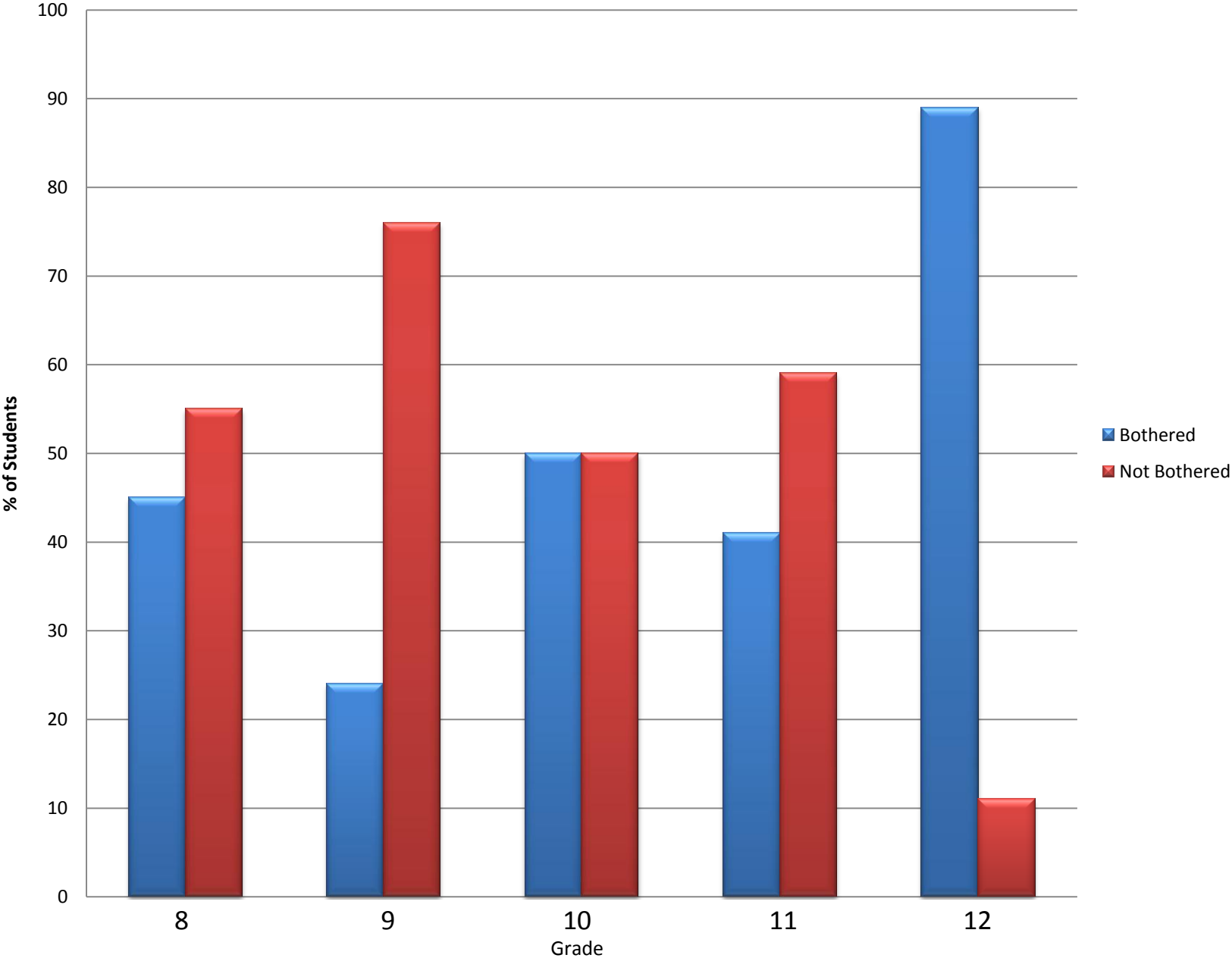

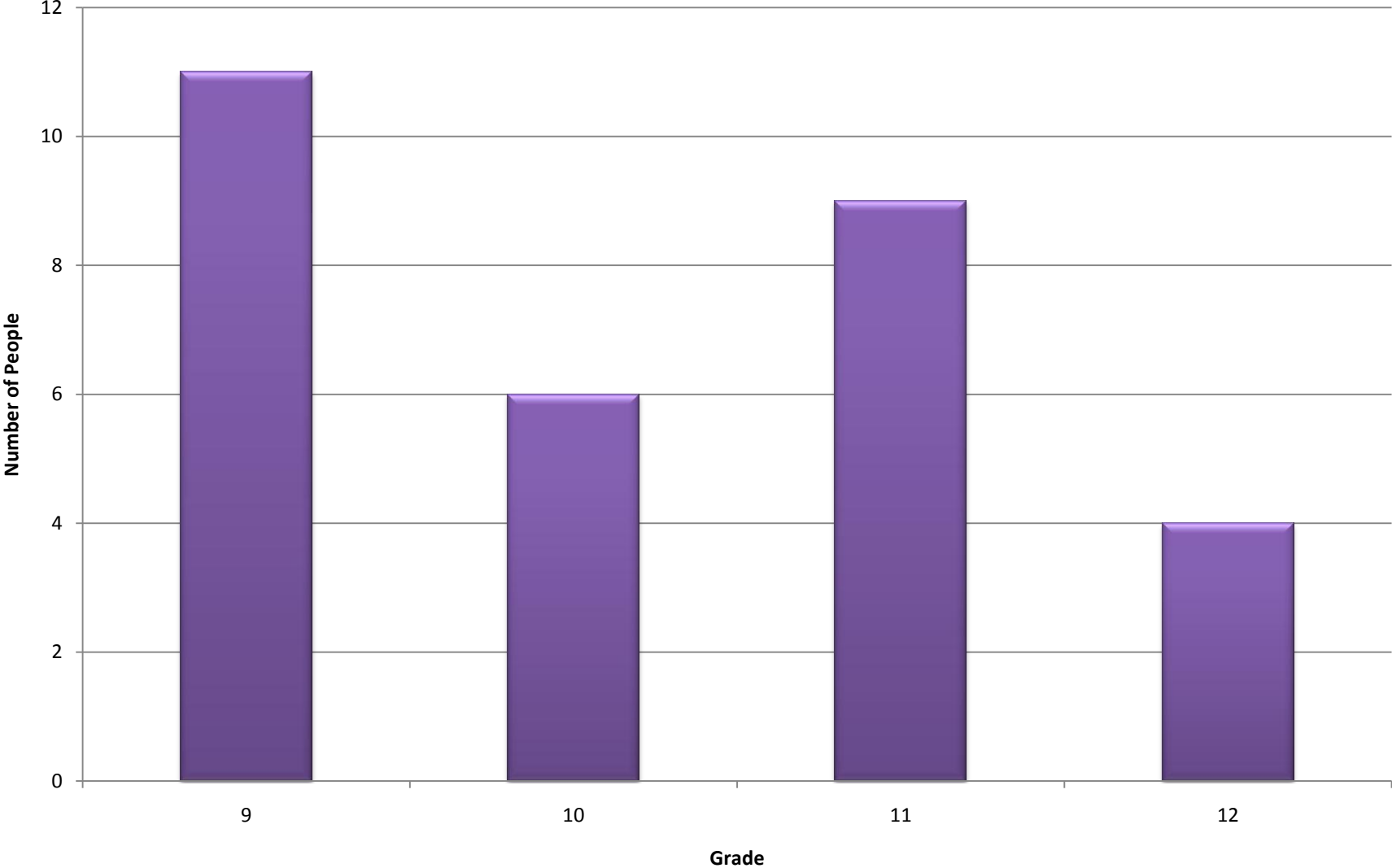
